Expiring Unit Standards / Unit standard Versions

Over the next few months we'll be updating you on the unit standards and unit standard versions that are due to expire in 2016.

This month we are looking at the unit standards that sit within the **Youth Work (Level 4) qualifications**. The following unit standard versions are due to expire:

16853 Demonstrate and apply knowledge of kawa and tikanga of tangata whenua in the youth development sector
Versions 1-3 expire 31 Dec 2016. Please use version 4 resources available on the Shop or Library

16862 Demonstrate knowledge of safety management in the youth development sector
Versions 1-4 expire 31 Dec 2016. Please use version 5 resources available on the Shop or Library

16856 Describe group work and leadership for youth work in the youth development sector
Version 4 expires 31 Dec 2016; Version 5 continues to be available

22250 Describe professional supervision for youth workers in the youth development sector
Version 1 expires 31 Dec 2016. Please use version 2 resources available on the Shop or Library

22253 Profile a community of relevance in the youth development sector
Version 1 expires 31 Dec 2016. Please use version 2 resources available on the Shop or Library

22256 Describe the principles, aims and goals of the Youth Development Strategy Aotearoa
Version 2 expires 31 Dec 2016. Please use version 3 resources available on the Shop or Library

All trainees currently completing the National Certificate in Youth Work (Level 4) combined resources in cd format must complete units 16862 and 22253 and be assessed by 31 Dec 2016, otherwise they must complete the new versions of both unit Standards.
