## New and improved iportal going live on 10 April 2017

The new iportal will make it easier for you to manage your trainees, submit results and give you access to the latest Assessor Guides within your scope.

### Re-registering on iportal

To access the new iportal, you'll need to re-register. But, you can't re-register until the website is live. We'll prompt you to do this when you first visit the new iportal (from 10 April 2017).

### Email address to use when re-registering


