Issue: Grammar and interpretation of range statement of PC 2.2
PC 2.2 and range statement currently reads:

Information obtained is from a wide range of material and resources.
Range yellow pages, Citizen Advice Bureaus, notice boards, libraries,
doctors' rooms, information counters, whānau, runanga.

Interpretation: As some regions do not have more than one CAB or library or information centre this range needs to be interpreted as a plural for total resources, not for each resource type listed

Information obtained is from a wide range of material and resources.
Range may include but is not limited to: yellow pages, Citizen Advice Bureaus,
notice boards, libraries, doctors' rooms, information counters, whānau,
runanga. A minimum of two resources are required.
