Issue: MOH has changed its Food and Nutrition Guidelines with age groupings reduced from six to five and a change of the ages of the groupings:

- infants and toddlers (0–2).
- children and young people (2–18).
- pregnant and breastfeeding women.
- adults.
- older people.

Our US refers to six groupings in EN3, and US range statements refer to “clients over the age of 16 years”.

Interpretation: Careerforce refers in learning and assessment resources to “people over the age of 18”. This meets the US range as well as the new MOH age groupings.

Action required: Unit standard to be revised to match the MOH Guidelines and 16 years to be changed to 18 years. Careerforce assessment materials meet the unit standard; assessor practice does not need to change.
