The key changes are:

28531 ('Transport people in a healthcare facility')

Outcome 1:

Prepare to transport a people in a healthcare facility.

1.2 Introductions are made and the identity of the person being transported is verified in accordance with organisational policies and procedures.

Range: verification includes but is limited to – checking personal identification wristband or other identification device used in the healthcare facility.

The proposed changes: (in bold)

1.2 **Where appropriate**, introductions are made and the identity of the person being transported is verified in accordance with organisational policies and procedures.

Range: verification includes but is limited to – checking personal identification wristband or **using** other identification **practice** used in the healthcare facility.

28532 ('Transport a deceased person in a healthcare facility')

Outcome 3:

Transport a deceased person in a healthcare facility.

3.2 The transport is completed in a manner that maintains respect for this person and their culture.

The proposed change: (in bold)

3.2 The transport is completed in a manner that maintains respect for the deceased person and their culture (**where known**).

28533 ('Transport body parts in a healthcare facility')

Outcome 2:

Transport body parts in a healthcare facility.

Range evidence is required of three separate transports.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Body parts are transported safely in accordance with organisational policies and procedures.
- 2.2 Body parts are transported in a manner that maintains respect for the person and their culture.

The proposed changes: (in bold)

Transport body parts in a healthcare facility.

Range evidence is required of **two** separate transports.

Performance criteria

- 2.1 Body parts are transported safely in accordance with organisational policies and procedures.
- 2.2 Body parts are transported in a manner that maintains respect for the person and their culture (**where known**).
